



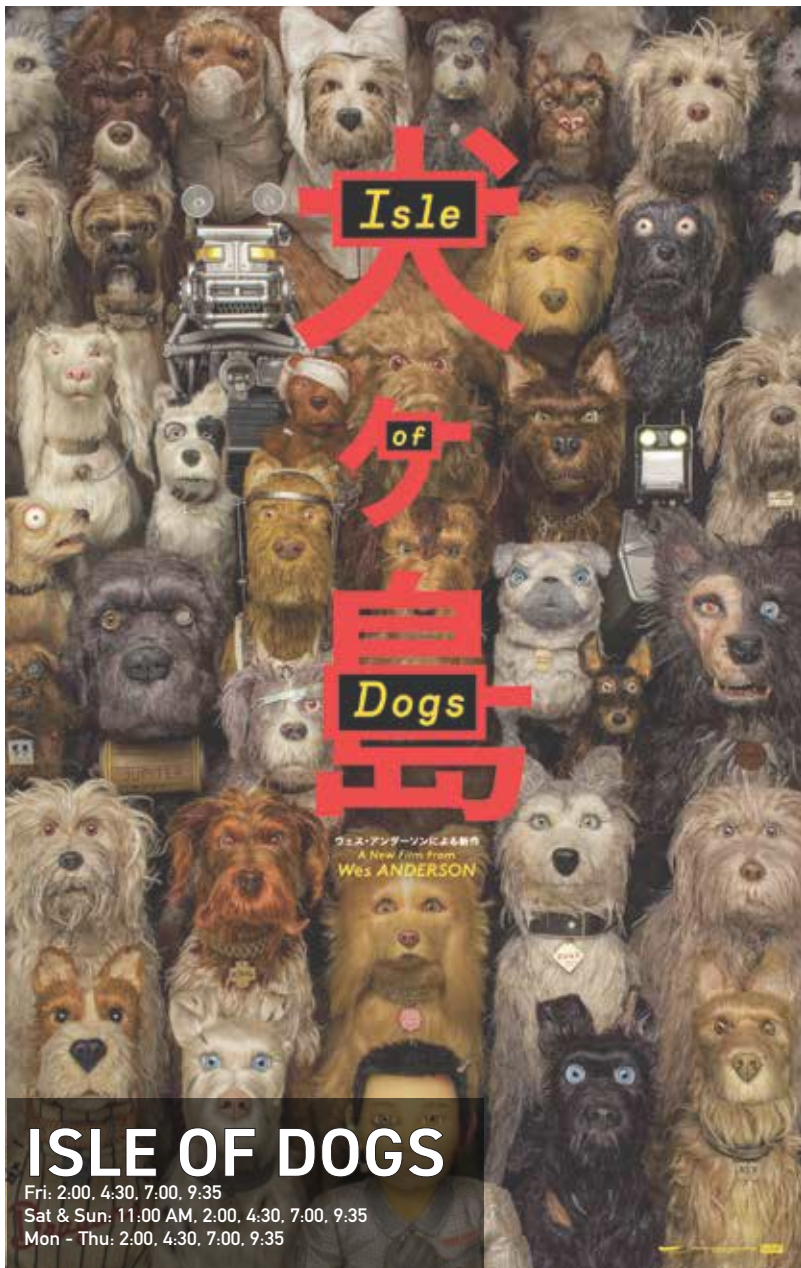

**Isle of Dogs**

The latest from quirky filmmaker Wes Anderson takes us to a dystopian future Japan where, by executive decree, all the canine pets of Megasaki City are exiled to a vast garbage-dump called Trash Island. 12-year-old Atari sets off alone in a miniature Junior-Turbo Prop and flies across the river in search of his bodyguard-dog, Spots. There, with the assistance of a pack of newly-found mongrel friends, he begins an epic journey that will decide the fate and future of the entire Prefecture.

**The Death of Stalin**

The one-liners fly as fast as political fortunes fall in this uproarious, wickedly irreverent satire from Armando Iannucci (Veep, In the Loop). Moscow, 1953: when tyrannical dictator Joseph Stalin drops dead, his parasitic cronies square off in a frantic power struggle to be the next Soviet leader. Among the contenders are the dweeby Georgy Malenkov (Jeffrey Tambor), the wily Nikita Khrushchev (Steve Buscemi), and the sadistic secret police chief Lavrentiy Beria (Simon Russell Beale).

**The Endless**

Filmmakers Justin Benson and Aaron Moorhead are also the stars of their creepy fantasy about two brothers who receive a message that compels them to revisit the remote commune where they were raised after the death of their mother. Despite having escaped, Aaron has fond memories of life in the cult; in some ways he prefers it to their current humdrum and friendless existence, and he wants to find emotional closure. Justin is warier. They will soon find out whose instincts were right as they return to a world of mystery where danger shadows their every step.
