



Music on Film Film on Music Grant Application

Thank you for applying to the Music on Film Film on Music grant! The MOFFOM grant will provide up to \$20,000 annually in finishing funds for documentary productions specifically for music licensing, scoring and composition. Awardees will be announced at the 42nd Denver Film Festival (November 2019).

GUIDELINES:

MOFFOM offers grants to selected feature-length documentary films in production and post-production

A film over 70 min in length is considered a feature-length film

We do not consider proposals for fiction films, docu-dramas, student projects, or outreach campaigns

Applicants must be 18 years or older

A fiscal sponsor is required to receive funding. The Denver Film Society offers a fiscal sponsorship program, but applicants can select a program of their choice. International applicants may apply, but must have a U.S. based fiscal sponsor should a grant be awarded. Grant recipients and their fiscal sponsors will be asked to review and sign a grant agreement and will be asked to submit progress reports on the project.

All grant submission are due on Wednesday, July 31, 2019 by 11:59PM

PROJECT NARRATIVE

- 1) Project Treatment (no more than two pages)
- 2) Amount requested and proposed specific use of the grant. Please include a list of examples of music you would like to use in the film and how they impact budgeting.
- 3) How will you measure the success of this project?

APPLICATION ATTACHMENTS

- 1) Full budget including funds raised to date
- 2) Three work samples. One should be footage from the project intended for the grant
- 3) List of the names, roles, and qualification of key individuals involved in the project including a music supervisor and fiscal sponsor
