Three Black queer femmes in their mid-30s take a road trip across the Midwestern United States in search of their friend who has seemingly disappeared off the grid.




Heightened Scrutiny

An introverted space princess is forced to leave her home planet on an inter-gay-lactic mission to save her exgirlfriend from the Straight White Maliens.




Move Ya Body: The Birth of House

Set in 1990s Syracuse, a promising undercover cop assigned to lure and arrest gay men defies professional orders when he falls in love with a target.




Queens of the Dead
